





Spaatz Award (SFO if under 21; Level I waived – see above)	Licensed physicians and Health Services Professionals (list in CAPR 160-1) with a doctorate.  <b>MAJOR (Maj)</b>	<p><b>For Maj:</b> Completion of all requirements for Level III (Grover Loening Award), three years time in grade as a Captain.</p>			Licensed physicians and health services officers; licensed attorneys with minimum 10 years experience; finance officers with a master's degree and CPA/CMA; educator with a doctorate and 5 years exp. All must have 1 year time in grade as a Capt.	A clergyperson with an earned doctorate degree in a ministry-related field and one year time in grade as a Capt.
 <b>LIEUTENANT COLONEL (Lt Col)</b>	<p><b>For Lt. Col:</b> Completion of all requirements for Level IV (Paul A. Garber Award), four years time in grade as a Major.</p>
